The Heart of Vocation award is an award given out to youth/young adult ministers that show a true heart for fostering vocations within their programs and parishes for the diocese. Two ministers will be recognized each quarter.

Award Includes:

- Certificate of excellence in the field of vocation work
- 250 dollars for the individual youth/young adult minister as a thank you
- Names of recipients published in the diocesan newspaper annually

How is the prize awarded?

1. How often have the youth/young adult ministers looked for opportunities to bring the vocation office out to speak with their youth? Has the youth/young adult minister been a liaison with their pastor to have Vocation Office come out and celebrate Mass? Has the youth/young adult minister made a culture of discernment within their program?
 2. How well does the youth/young adult minister do at bringing men and women to vocation events sponsored by the diocese?
 3. What kind of “scouting report” does the youth/young adult minister give to the vocation office? Does minister make connections and introductions between the person discerning and vocation office?
