With help from our local hosts, the Down Syndrome Guild of Dallas, the Down Syndrome Partnership of North Texas, and the Green Oaks School, we are recruiting volunteers for a fun and rewarding weekend.

To provide the best convention experience for over 600 youth & adults with Down syndrome, we need extensive volunteer support over the three days. No previous experience is necessary just a desire to interact directly with people with Down syndrome and a willingness to have fun! Most importantly is support for our **Youth & Adults Conference** and **Kids' Camp**. Volunteers for the Youth & Adults Conference lead a group of eight individuals with Down syndrome ages 15 and older in activities and workshops planned and presented by their peers. Volunteers for Kids' Camp assist children ages 6 months to 14 years while they participate in crafts, games, and educational activities. During this time, their parents participate in the General Convention.
